Submission Guidelines:

Current undergraduates may submit a written work no longer than 3000 words, visual art, or music. A 300-word articulation of how the work is related to at least one significant philosophical idea or theme is also required. When appropriate, these 300 word blurbs will be published alongside the work. Stance asks that each undergraduate only submit one work for the journal per year. Works will be evaluated by appropriate criteria that may include but are not limited to: grace, vivacity, movement (development or conflict & resolution), immediacy, evocative power, and most importantly, association with at least one philosophical idea or theme.
